

INP- 020. PROTOCOL FOR SEMEN COLLECTION FOR POST-VASECTOMY CONTROL

PURPOSE:

To assess the fertility of sperm following vasectomy.

PREPARATION

- Two samples are usually collected after vasectomy, but you should follow your doctor's recommendations.
- Never collect semen until 3-4 months after vasectomy, and a minimum of 25 ejaculations.
- To collect a second semen sample after vasectomy, wait 1 month after the result of the first post-vasectomy semen analysis.
- Maintain abstinence for a minimum of 2 days and a maximum of 7 days.
- Do not collect the sample if fever or illness has occurred within the previous 7 days.

SAMPLE COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

- Empty the bladder before collecting semen.
- Wash hands and genitals with soap, rinsing thoroughly with water.
- To obtain the semen by masturbation, collecting **the entire** sample.
- Do not use condoms to collect the sample.
- Collect the sample in a sterile wide-mouth plastic container.
- Protect semen from light, cold and intense heat. Try to carry it close to the body to keep it at the right temperature (as close to 36°C as possible, which is the usual body temperature).
- The sample should be delivered to the hospital's collection office <u>preferably within 1 hour</u> of collection and no later than 2 hours.
